## Govt nod to 14 institutes for medical and dental colleges

BHUBANESWAR, Nov. 25. — The state government has issued no objection certificates (NOCs), to 14 private institutions for establishment of medical and dental colleges at six places across the state.

Responding to question asked by BJP member, Mr Aswini Kumar Patra, the health minister, Mr Bijoysree Routray, said that amongst the 22 private institutions who have sought the state government's permission to establish medical and dental colleges in the state, 14 had been issued permission.

Institutions like Vinayak Mission, Lord Jagannath Institute of Medical and Dental Sciences and Research, MEDWIN Educational Society, Blue Wheel National Health Care and Educational Trust, Siksha O' Anusandhan, Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology, Vigyan Bharati Charitable Trust and Vidya Bharati Educational Trust have opted for opening medical and dental colleges at Bhubaneswar. However, PVN Rao Trust, Sri Venkateswar Education and Health Trust has proposed to set up a medical and dental college in Ganjam district.

Two Puri-based institutions, namely National Health Organisation and Sri Jagannath Medical Education and Charitable Trust have intended to open a medical college and a dental college respectively in Puri while Western Orissa Development Council has proposed to set up a medical and dental college at Bolangir.

Society for Proliferation of Knowledge in Health and Education and its Service to People Society has sought government permission for establishment of a medical college at Rayagada, while SP Charitable Trust has proposed to set up a dental college at Balasore and Vidya Jyoti Trust has intended to establish a medical college at Phulnakhara in Cuttack district.

Replying to a query, the health minister said there was no

proposal to set up a government medical college at Balasore. However, a private organisation had conducted a survey for establishment of a medical college and selected Balasore as the suitable site.

When the ministers attention was drawn to the ongoing agitation in Mayurbhanj demanding establishment of a medical college at Baripada, Mr Routray said if any private organisation comes forward to set up a medical college at Baripada, the government will certainly provide all support.
