## 1.5 lakh jobs if all MoUs come through

More than 1.5 lakh people will get jobs in the industry sector if all MoUs signed by the Orissa Government come through. The Chief Minister, Naveen Patnaik, on Tuesday called a high level meeting to review the possible employment opportunities in Orissa.

The CM directed the director of industries to ensure development of ancillary industries and support services required for the oncoming industries. He has been asked to prepare a necessary action plan for important industrial clusters like Kalinganagar, Dhenkanal, Angul, Sambalpur, Jharsuguda, Rourkela, Paradip, Barbil, Keonjhar, Raygada and Kalahandi.

The Government has decided that the employment situation in industries that have signed MoUs with the government will be monitored by the District Collectors. The Director of Technical Education and Training (DTE&T) will organise refresher and reorientation programmes for students to enable them to avail employment opportunities in Orissa.

"It must take initiatives to organise campus interviews and hone skills of students so that they can get employment in various industries," said an official. The DTE&T will designate one of its officers as a nodal officer for each industrial clusters and districts.

They will monitor the ground realities and coordinate with the industrial houses and the State government officials. They will act as a facilitator for the local youth. The nodal officers will be appointed at Jharsuguda, Duburi, Rayagda and Angul.

It was decided in the meeting that industries would be advised to adopt a transparent procedure for selection and recruitment of manpower and to keep the concerned District Collector informed about it.
